

Search Incidents

The Search Incident feature allows you to view details associated with specific incidents. You can search very broadly or quite specifically if you need to.



From the **Incidents (1)** tab, select **“Search Incidents (2).”**

Select different options to make your search more or less specific (3). Notice that the date range for the search defaults to the current school year.

Note: To search by problem behavior or administrative decision, first select the incident type (Major, Minor, SESIR).

Click **“Search (4).”**

Click on the **date** of an incident to view the details of a referral (5).
